GAL Xlokk Foundation is publishing a call for applications for the above-mentioned sub-measures of M19.2 under the LEADER programme 2014-2020. The actions form part of Local Development Strategy for the South-East territory.

Measure 1 supports the restoration of small-scale objects of significant cultural and historical value to the territory with reasonable free access by the general public. The eligible beneficiaries are voluntary organisations, local councils and natural persons. The measure has an indicative budget of €63,569.61.

Measure 2 provides support for the setting up and/or quality improvement of activities, events, experiences and sessions of cultural and social value, that have a strong link to the historical, social and cultural development of the region. Investments should be aimed to infrastructure for new or improved cultural and social ideas. The eligible beneficiaries are voluntary organisations. The measure has an indicative budget of €120,000.

Measure 3 supports the documentation and/or digitalisation of information, branding, advertising, and dissemination of information related to the cultural heritage; the setting up of heritage tours and trails joining up different attractions/sites of tourist importance. The eligible beneficiaries are voluntary organisations, local councils and private entities. The measure has an indicative budget of €30,000.

Applications will open on the 11th November 2022, with the first set of applications being accepted until the 14th December 2022, at noon. Applications remain open until the respective measure's budget is absorbed as indicated in the guidance notes.
